**Ensemble Information:** Required etudes for ensemble auditions will be available by May 1<sup>st</sup> to those registered. Due to the limited practice time available, only students participating in all 4 days of camp will be able to participate as ensemble performers. Single day campers may watch ensemble rehearsal, use the time for individual or group practice, or leave early.

**Masterclass Information:** REGISTERED students interested in performing in a Masterclass should contact Karen Kontos at [president@azflutes.org](mailto:president@azflutes.org) no later than April 30th to be scheduled. Due to time constraints, the number of performers will be limited. No extra fee is required, however a copy of the music you intend to perform must be provided to Karen by April 30th. Students may choose a solo work (an accompanist will be provided) or orchestral excerpt. Please indicate if there is a preference to play in the Thursday or Saturday class. If demand is greater than capacity, the performers shall be selected by random drawing and notified of the results on May 1<sup>st</sup>. The Masterclass is open to all camp students to participate as auditors (copies of the music being performed will be provided). Masterclass attendance is optional - students may choose to attend an alternate class during this time slot as shown on the schedule.
