*Flutist-composer-pianist Gary Schocker is an accomplished musician of outstanding versatility. At age 15, he made his professional debut when he performed as soloist with the New York Philharmonic and the Philadelphia Orchestra. He has won numerous competitions including the Young Concert Artists, the National Flute Association, the NY Flute Club, and the East-West Artists. He often concertizes in duo with guitarist Jason Vieaux. Internationally, he has toured and taught in Colombia, Panama, Canada, Australia, Taiwan, Japan, Germany, France, and Italy. Schocker is the most published living composer for the flute.*

### Masterclass Information

Four groups will be chosen by lottery among the applicants. Flutists must be in 9<sup>th</sup> grade or older and **must be current members of the AFS**. Performers must prepare a composition for flute duet, trio, quartet, choir, or flute and mixed instruments chosen from repertoire composed by Gary Schocker (see [garyschocker.com/Gary\\_Schocker/compositions\\_with\\_flute.html](http://garyschocker.com/Gary_Schocker/compositions_with_flute.html)). No more than four groups will perform, in addition to the AFS Alla Breve Flute Choir. Pieces must be performed with the instrumentation for which it was written. The selection must be performance-ready. Teachers' recommendations are required for applicants in high school to confirm the students' high level of preparation.
